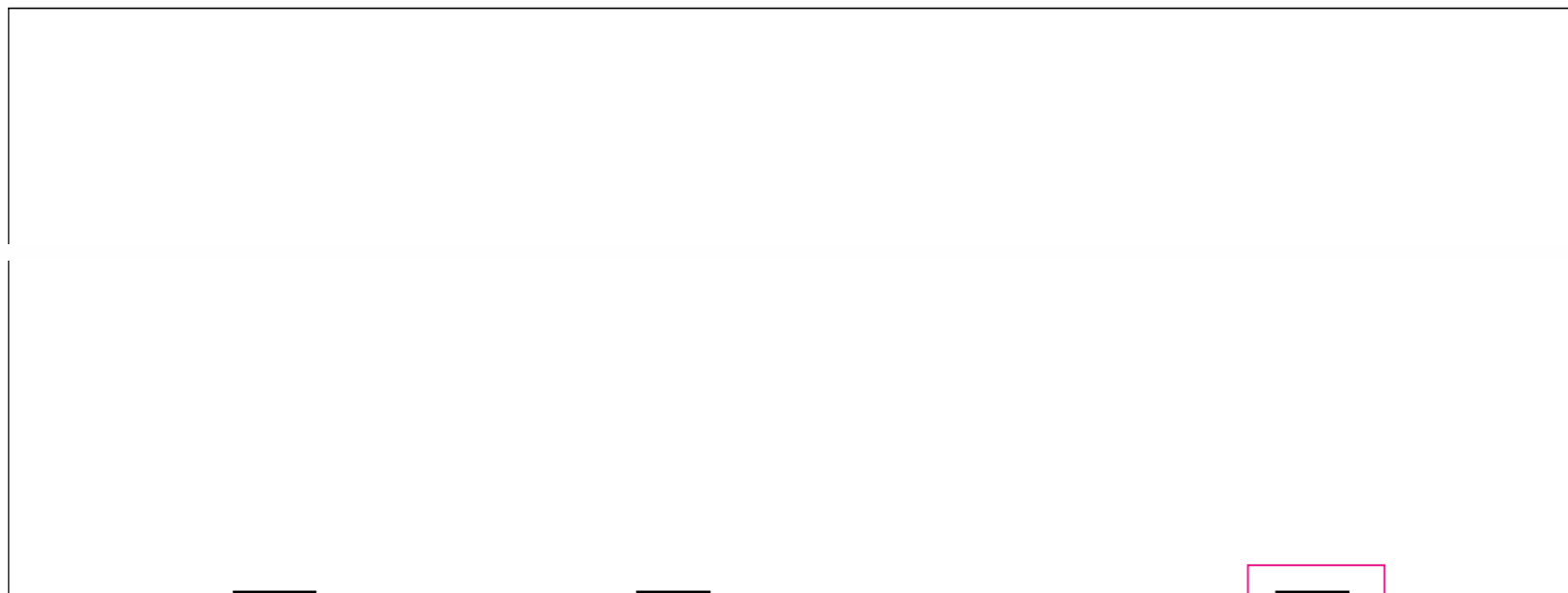

Window s11 as existing, internally.

Opening is currently glazed with unpolished Georgian wired glass which was a temporary measure that has never been revisited.

Ferramenta remains in place, in mismatched wrought iron, with remains of lead ties still evident. Whilst these require decorative repair and resetting into the stonework, they can be retained.

NB This studio has only produced an initial sketch without fee to establish a design in principle, based on a written brief provided by the commissioning family.

It is proposed to mount the window onto the original glass line, using lead ribbon ties to mount the new panel to the repaired ferramenta. Minor making good to the internal plasterwork and external repointing work will be undertaken in lime based mortars in line with the existing materials.

NB This studio has only produced an initial sketch without fee to establish a design in principle, based on a written brief provided by the commissioning family.

Design inspiration has been taken from the existing glass at Llanrhychwyn, translating the flora from the family brief into painted quarels of glass similar to those fragmented in other windows. The remainder of the brief - the view - is incorporated into the roundel as if it has been inset from elsewhere. The ultimate dimensions and positioning of this will be worked out to fall more neatly against the existing ferramenta, which will sit on the internal face of the glass. Space for a dedication has been allowed at the bottom.

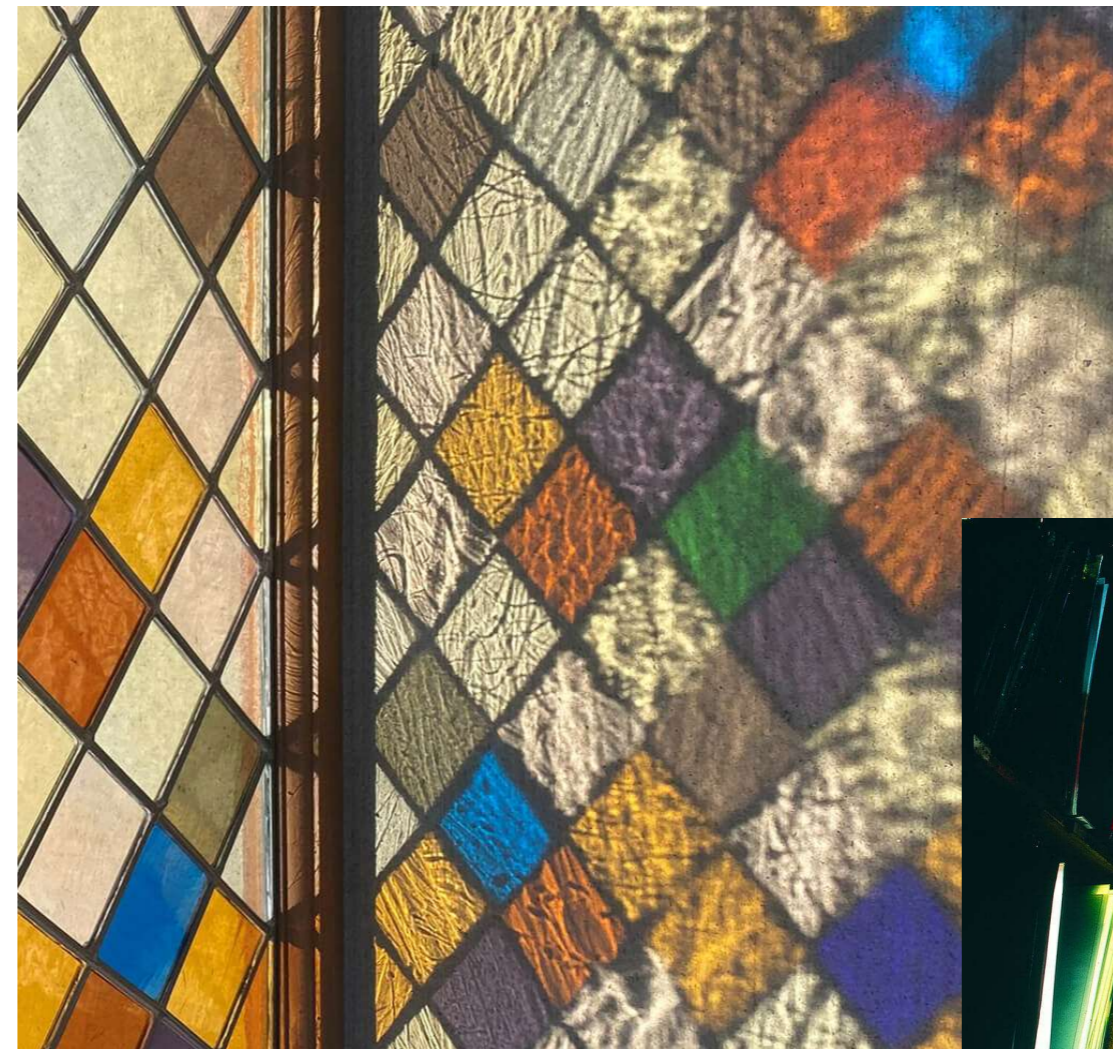

- Glass - Lamberts mouth-blown cylinder glass
- Lead - Heaps traditional lead came
- Paints - Kiln fired, hand painted, silver stains and vitreous glass paint
- Ties - Lead ribbon
- Fixing mortar - NHL at 3:1 with fine-sieved Brynkir sand
