THE ECCLESIASTICAL EXEMPTION (LISTED BUILDINGS AND CONSERVATION **AREAS) ORDER 1994** APPLICATION FOR A FACULTY / CONSULTATION

St Cybi, Holyhead

I refer to your letter enclosing a faculty application in respect of works to the above named church.

Cadw's Inspector of Historic Buildings (Conservation), Aimee Henderson has considered the proposal and made these comments:

The listed building comprises the remains of a Roman fort which encloses the Church of St Cybi and its associated upper churchyard. The fort is also a Scheduled Monument (ref. AN031) and scheduled monument consent for these works has already been secured along with detailed conditions provided by Cadw's Inspector of Ancient Monuments. As such, the works are very well detailed and supported by thorough documentation including a Statement of Significance and Heritage Impact Assessment. The works will remove damaging vegetation growth and later additions including modern steel gates. Repairs are planned to be carried out using appropriate methods and materials in line with best conservation practice. The repairs will safeguard this highly significant monument and preserve it for future generations, while also opening the churchyard for greater public access and appreciation of this important group of highly listed heritage assets.
